During the operation, forest



teams conducted extensive patrols across sensitive forest zones, tiger reserves, and national parks to secure both wildlife and forest resources. Traps, electric snares, and other illegal hunting tools were seized anď destroyed.

Authorities kept a close watch

on habitual offenders, intensifying

surveillance across key regions.
Under the leadership of nodal officers, teams across tiger reserves, general forest divisions, and project areas executed highimpact anti-poaching drives, resulting in major arrests.

Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Wildlife), Shubhranjan Sen, praised the dedication of the 22,610 officers and staff who participated in the operation. Over 931 cases of forest crimes were registered, with 3,160 suspects under surveillance and 328 vehicles seized. The patrolling effort was staggering—8.28 lakh km on foot and 17.83 lakh km by vehicle.

Five Arrested for Providing **Mule Accounts to Cyber** Criminals in Bhopal

Bhopal: Bhopal's Cyber Crime Branch has taken decisive action against local accomplices aiding cyber fraudsters by providing mule bank accounts. Acting on intelligence received through the Sammanvay Portal, authorities registered four cases and arrested five individuals involved in these illicit activities.

According to the police, complaints were lodged on the Sammanvay Portal, a central government platform monitoring cyber crimes, regarding Bhopal-based mule bank accounts being used in fraudulent transactions across multiple states. In response, notices were issued to the concerned banks to track down the account holders linked to these

After conducting a thorough technical analysis and field investigations, cyber crime teams identified and apprehended individuals responsible for facilitating mule accounts. As part of the crackdown, mobile phones, SIM cards, and bank accounts used in

A youth who lost his hand in a train accident committed suicide by hanging himself he hanged himself.

Bhopal: A youth living in Kolar area committed suicide by hanging himself. His wife had died a month ago. Before this, one of his hands had also been cut off in an accident. Police have started investigation after regis-

Kolar police said that 35-year-old Jeetu Suryavanshi, son of Ram Singh Survavanshi, lived in Bajari area. He returned home drunk on Thursday night. After this, he went straight to his room. At around 8:30 pm, when his mother reached to give him food, Jeetu was found hanging from the noose. When his mother screamed loudly, Jeet's brother reached there and took him down from the noose and took him to JK Hospital. Here the doctor declared him dead. As soon as the information of the incident was received, the police reached the spot and started action by preparing a Panchnama. Police have not found a suicide note from the spot. Initial interrogation with the family members revealed that Jeetu was badly injured last year due to being hit by a train. His right hand was cut off. Three fingers of his left hand were also cut off. His wife also died last month. His two children were looked after by his mother and his two brothers. It is believed that due to all these problems,

Youth dies during treatment

The youth injured in the Scorpio overturning died in the hospital during treatment. A youth died immediately at the time of the accident. Nishatpura police said that on Sunday night, a speeding Scorpio overturned after hitting a divider near Truba College. In this accident, a youth named Faizan died on the spot while seven others were injured. Among them, 20year-old Sheheryar Khan died in a private Hospital on Thursday during treatment. Police have registered a case and started investigation.
