

“Empty Plates” and hollow promises

Congress’s “Khayali Pulao” protest



Bhopal: In a striking symbolic gesture, Congress legislators in Madhya Pradesh staged a unique demonstration on the fourth day of the Assembly session. Led by Leader of Opposition (LoP) Umang Singh, the lawmakers gathered within the Assembly premises holding empty steel plates, accusing the BJP-led government of serving

“Khayali Pulao”—fanciful, unfulfilled dreams—for the citizens instead of tangible governance.

Allegations of policy paralysis

The LoP launched a scathing critique of the administration, labeling its claims as “hollow declarations.” Singh pointed out that despite massive announcements re-

garding employment, recruitment processes have remained stalled for over two years, leaving thousands of youths in a state of uncertainty. He further alleged that the promised hike in the Ladli Behna scheme to Rs 3,000 per month remains purely on paper, while families continue to struggle with mounting electricity bills and a crumbling healthcare system plagued by a shortage of doctors and essential medicines.

The battle for public dignity

Beyond economic grievances, the Congress highlighted the government’s failure to implement the 27% OBC reservation and the declining standards of the state’s education sector. “This isn’t just a political stunt; it is a fight for the rights and dignity of 7.5 crore people,” Singh asserted. By clattering plates in a rhythmic protest, the opposition sent a clear message: the public’s patience is wearing thin. The Congress vowed to continue its crusade from the Assembly floors to the streets until the government transitions from “imaginary recipes” to real-world action for the farmers, youth, and women of Madhya Pradesh.

Former IAS Niyaz Khan urges BJP to appoint Muslim Ministers

Debate sparks as Bangladesh appoints two Hindu Ministers



Bhopal: Following the recent formation of the Tarique Rahman-led BNP government in Bangladesh, a fresh political debate has surfaced in India. The new Bangladeshi cabinet includes Nitai Roy Chowdhury as a prominent Hindu minister, a move that reflects minority representation in the neighboring nation.

This development prompted former Madhya Pradesh IAS officer and author Niyaz Khan to take to social media, urging the Bharatiya Janata Party

(BJP) to reconsider its own cabinet composition regarding Muslim representation.

A plea for proportional representation

In a post on X (formerly Twitter), Khan expressed his delight over the appointment of Hindu ministers in Bangladesh but highlighted a striking disparity. He noted that while Bangladesh has approximately one crore Hindus represented in its cabinet, India, with a Muslim population of 20 crore, currently

has no Muslim ministers in the Union Cabinet. “I am surprised,” Khan wrote, making a “humble request” to the BJP and RSS to seriously consider appointing two to three Muslim ministers to ensure a more inclusive governance model.

Political opposition echoes concerns

The sentiment was mirrored by senior Congress

leader Tarique Anwar, who questioned the Prime Minister on whether India’s current cabinet reflects the “inclusive governance” often promised.

Anwar pointed out that if Bangladesh can integrate minorities into its leadership, India should address the “zero” representation of Muslims in its executive
