

# Brazil shows interest in cooperation with India in the health sector

New Delhi (UNI)

Brazil has expressed its intention to establish cooperation with India for the production of medicines and vaccines.

Brazilian Health Minister, Alexandre Padilha, who is accompanying President Lula da Silva on his State visit to India, met union Health Minister J P Nadda here on Wednesday. He said the proposed partnership includes public institutions and companies from both countries for the production of cancer drugs and also medicines to combat tropical diseases.

Padilha also met Prataprao Jadhav



(Traditional Medicine), expressing his government's intention to expand cooperation regarding free access to

health services for the people.

"Brazil and India have robust public systems, strong scientific capacity, and a strategic role in the Global South. Our cooperation in health can expand the population's access to medicines, strengthen local production, and boost innovation," the Brazilian Minister said.

Padilha invited the Indian leaders to join the Global Coalition for Local and Regional Production, Innovation and Equitable Access. "We want India and Brazil to be at the forefront of a new

international health agenda based on local production, innovation and solidarity-based cooperation," he said.

According to Padilha, the exchange of knowledge in digital health can contribute to the modernisation of the SUS (Brazilian Public Health System), expand access, and improve the quality of care for the population.

Another proposal was the implementation of a digital library of traditional medicine, bringing together scientific evidence, protocols, clinical studies, historical records, and best practices on integrative and complementary health practices.

## Mahua Moitra files for custody of pet dog with Delhi HC

New Delhi: Trinamool Congress MP Mahua Moitra, has moved the Delhi High Court challenging a lower court order that refused to grant her interim custody of her pet Rottweiler, Henry.

Earlier in November last year, the Saket District Court dismissed Moitra's request seeking custody of the dog for 10 days each month.

On Thursday, a single-judge bench of the High Court issued notice to advocate Jai Anant Dehdrai, who currently has the custody of Henry, and asked him to respond to Moitra's plea.

Dehdrai, who appeared in person, and Moitra have been involved in multiple legal disputes over the past few years. Previously, Dehdrai alleged that Moitra accepted bribes from businessman in exchange for raising questions in Parliament.



## DMDK strengthens DMK-led Front

Enters into alliance for the ensuing TN Assembly polls

## PM Modi, Abu Dhabi Crown Prince elevate AI and Advanced Tech as Core Pillar of India-UAE ties?

India and the United Arab Emirates on Thursday elevated artificial intelligence and advanced technologies to the forefront of their bilateral partnership, as Prime Minister Narendra Modi met Sheikh Khaled bin Mohamed bin Zayed Al Nahyan on the sidelines of the AI Impact Summit in New Delhi.

Sheikh Khaled, Crown Prince of Abu Dhabi, is on a two-day official visit to India from February 18-19 to participate in the Summit, marking his second official visit since September 2024.

The meeting reaffirmed what both sides described as the strength and expanding scope of the India-UAE Comprehensive Strategic Partnership.

According to an official release from the Prime Minister's Office, the two leaders underscored that Artificial



Intelligence and emerging technologies would form a central pillar of future cooperation.

They welcomed the finalisation of a term sheet between India's Centre for Development of Advanced Comput-

ing (C-DAC), G42 and Mohamed Bin Zayed University of AI for the deployment of a supercomputer cluster in India.

The project follows an announcement made jointly by Prime Minister Modi and UAE President Sheikh Mohamed bin Zayed Al Nahyan during the latter's visit to India on January 19, 2026.

The supercomputer cluster will be integrated into the AI India Mission and made accessible to public and private sector entities for research, application development and commercial use.

The leaders also discussed expanding collaboration in strategic sectors such as space, nuclear energy, technology and innovation, signalling a broadening of the technology partnership beyond AI alone.

## Around 20 lakh voter documents await fresh verification in Bengal


With barely three days remaining before the February 21 deadline, the scrutiny of voters' documents submitted during claims and objections hearings in West Bengal is facing fresh hurdles as around 20 lakh sets of documents are still awaiting re-verification by District Magistrates, who also function as District Electoral Officers (DEOs).

Officials in the office of the Chief Electoral Officer, West Bengal, said a bulk of the pending cases fall under the category of "logical discrepancies."

According to them, micro-observers flagged inconsistencies during the ongoing verification exercise, noting that several submissions did not tally with the 13 identity documents recognised by the Election Commission of India.

"Based on the observations made during scrutiny, such cases were sent back to the concerned DEOs for another round of verification. The Commission has instructed the officers to complete the process and submit their reports at the earliest," a senior official in the CEO's office said.

Adding to the delay, officials confirmed that nearly 1.14 lakh documents submitted during the hearing process are yet to be uploaded on the system. As a result, scrutiny of those applica-



cations has not even begun.

In light of these developments, meeting the February 21 deadline appears uncertain. There is a strong possibility that the scrutiny timeline may be extended once again, which could also push back the publication of the final voters' list," sources said.

At present, the final electoral roll is scheduled to be released on February 28, after the earlier date of February 14 was revised.

Meanwhile, a full bench of the Election Commission of India is expected to visit West Bengal on March 1 for a two-day review of the situation following the Special Intensive Review (SIR) exercise.

Sources said the Commission is considering holding the elections in fewer phases compared to previous polls. While the CEO's office has suggested a single-phase election, the final call will rest with the Commission.

**Nagpur engineer remains in Mali jail despite bail**  
Nagpur: An engineer from Nagpur continues to remain incarcerated in Mali despite being granted bail by a local court, prompting his wife to seek urgent intervention from Indian authorities. Nitin Gulhane, a resident of Nagpur, has been lodged in a Malian prison since February last year in connection with an alleged financial dispute involving a company based in Uttar Pradesh. Although a court in Mali granted him bail in August 2025, he has not yet been released.
